Julian Chela-Flores: Astrobiology and Humanism. Conversations on Science, Philosophy and Theology. Cambridge Scholars Publishing (2019).

In this succinct and highly interesting set of reflections on astrobiology, Prof. Julian Chela-Flores provides an unusually broad-minded study.
